

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE TRAFFIC, ADOPTING BY REFERENCE PORTIONS OF THE OREGON STATE TRAFFIC CODE, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF LAKESIDE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption of State Act: The following enumerated Sections of Chapter 483, Oregon Revised Statutes, as the same appear on the date hereof, are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this Ordinance: 483.002 through 483.038, 483.044 through ORS 483.050 (2), 483.102 and 483.104, 483.112 through 483.120, 483.122, 483.126 through 483.222, 483.302 through 483.318, 483.330 through 483.345, 483.362 through 483.366, 483.380 through 483.474, 483.474, 483.497 through 483.646, 483.710 through 483.999.

All acts which are made unlawful by the above mentioned sections of the State Motor Vehicle Laws shall be considered as offenses against the City of Lakeside when committed within the boundaries and shall be punished by the penalties set forth under said state motor vehicle laws as provided therein, which shall, for the purposes of this Ordinance, supersede all other penalties.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 1 of the City of Lakeside, adopted September 19, 1974 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. It is hereby declared necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of Lakeside and its inhabitants that this Ordinance be in full force and effect immediately; and on account thereof, the Council hereby declares an emergency to exist and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and is approved by the Mayor.

The foregoing Ordinance is duly passed by the Council of the City of Lakeside by unanimous vote of the Councilmen and sub-

mitted to the Mayor and approved by the Mayor all on this 20th day  
of March, 1975.
