

ORDINANCE NO. 102

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF A CITY TAX BASE ELECTION IN THE CITY OF LAKESIDE, OREGON ON NOVEMBER 6, 1984 FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF LAKESIDE, OREGON, THE QUESTION OF ESTABLISHING A TAX BASE FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPLYING THE LIMITATION ON TAXATION SET FORTH IN SECTION 11, ARTICLE XI, OREGON CONSTITUTION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lakeside, Oregon has determined that a tax base should be established as authorized by Subsection (2), Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, in order to permit the proper operation of the city affairs within the limitation contained in Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to submit the question of establishing a tax base to the legal voters of the City of Lakeside, Oregon.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF LAKESIDE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Date of Election. The proposition set forth in Section 2 of this ordinance shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in this Ordinance to the legal voters of the City of Lakeside, Oregon at a city tax base election to be held on November 6, 1984.

Section 2. Form of Proposition. At the city tax base election there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Lakeside, Oregon for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

ESTABLISHING A CITY OF LAKESIDE TAX BASE

QUESTION: Shall a tax base of \$64,463.00 be established to maintain city services?

EXPLANATION: The City of Lakeside has no tax base. The tax base amount of \$64,463.00 covers a one-year projection of tax revenue needed for operating purposes for Fiscal Year 1984-85. Taxes will not, however, be levied until Fiscal Year 1985-86. Taxes will then be levied only as needed within the tax base. The amount levied within the tax base will be partially financed by the State of Oregon. Projected non-tax revenue covers 47% of costs. Anticipated tax rate, not including a levy for bonded indebtedness, is \$3.03 per \$1,000.00 assessed valuation. Once the full amount of the tax base is taxed an increase beyond 6% requires voter approval. Any excess tax collections will be applied to the city operating expenses for the following fiscal year.

Section 3. Election Part of Statewide General Election. There is a regular statewide general election being held in the State of Oregon and in the City of Lakeside on November 6, 1984 and this city tax base election is called to be held concurrent therewith, and as a part thereof.

Section 4. Election Boards. The city tax base election shall be handled by, and the city tax base ballots counted by, the same election boards that handle the regular statewide general election in the election precincts in which the City of Lakeside is located, at the regular statewide general election to be held on November 6, 1984. Such election boards hereby are designated as the election boards for the city tax base election and shall hold their respective offices as designated for the regular statewide general election.

Section 5. Voting Hours. The polls for the city tax base election shall be opened in each of the voting precincts at the same hour, and shall be kept open until the same hour, as the polls are opened and closed for the regular statewide general election that will be held on the same day.

Section 6. Qualified Voters. The election boards handling the election shall permit only those electors to vote on the question of establishing a city tax base who are otherwise qualified to vote at the regular statewide general election and who reside within the boundaries of the City of Lakeside.

Section 7. Notice of Election. Notice of the city tax base election shall be given by publication twice in the World, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Coos Bay, Oregon, not more than 30 nor less than 10 days before the election. Notices of the city tax base election shall be posted for not less than 20 days before the election in three public places within the City. The notice in the newspaper and that posted in three public places shall be in substantially the following form:

NOTICE OF MEASURE ELECTION
CITY OF LAKESIDE

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, November 6, 1984, an election will be held in the City of Lakeside, Coos County, Oregon. The polls will be open from 3:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. The following question shall be submitted to the qualified voters thereof:

ESTABLISHING A CITY OF LAKESIDE TAX BASE

QUESTION: Shall a tax base of \$64,463.00 be established to maintain city services?

EXPLANATION: The City of Lakeside has no tax base. The tax base amount of \$64,463.00 covers a one-year projection of tax revenue needed for operating purposes for Fiscal Year 1984-85. Taxes will not, however, be levied until Fiscal Year 1985-86. Taxes will then be levied only as needed within the tax base. The amount levied within the tax base will be partially financed by the State of Oregon. Projected non-tax revenue covers 47% of costs. Anticipated tax rate, not including a levy for bonded indebtedness, is \$3.03 per \$1,000.00 assessed valuation. Once the full amount of the tax base is taxed an increase beyond 6% requires voter approval. Any excess tax collections will be applied to the city operating expenses for the following fiscal year.

Adopted by the City Council of the City of Lakeside on this 16th day of August, 1984. This Ordinance shall take effect on September 16, 1984, the thirtieth day after its enactment.
