AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY TO VOTE ON THE QUESTION OF DISINCORPORATION AND PROVIDING THE PROCEDURE THEREFORE; AND DECLARING AN EMERCENCY.

## THE CITY OF LAKESIDE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In that a petition for disincorporation has been filed with the City and in that ORS 221.620 requires an election on the issue of disincorporation and the Council having determined the petition to have been signed by the necessary percentage of electors, such election shall be held on the <u>12th</u> day of \_\_June \_\_\_ , 1975.

Section 2. The polls for said election shall be at the Lakeside Rural Fire Protection District fire hall within the City. The polls shall remain open from 8:00 A.M. o'clock to 8:00 P.M. o'clock.

Section 3. Steve Herman, City Recorder, shall be the Clerk of said election; and Margaret Sheehan, Chairman and Murial Bowron are hereby appointed judges of said election and shall constitute the Election Board. Said judges shall receive \$ 30.00 as compensation for their service:

The Election Board shall count the votes Section 4. cast and return them to the Clerk who shall call to his assistance the County Clerk and a district judge to canvass the returns. A written statement of the canvass shall be made and signed by the canvassers or a majority of them and filed with the Clerk of the Election pursuant to ORS 221.640 (2).

Section 5. The Clerk shall prepare the election ballot pursuant to ORS 221.630 and shall publish a reasonable facsimile thereof in a newspaper of general circulation and at the same time he shall publish the Notice of Election as provided hereinafter.

Section 6. The Clerk shall publish notice of the time and place of the election in a newspaper of general circulation in the city at least 10 days prior to the election and in addition, post in three public places in the City copies of such notice.

Section 7. Whereas the continued efficient operation of the City, together with planning, funding, budgeting and service providing functions of the City require an immediate resolution of the question of disincorporation and to protect the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City, an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage by the Council and its approval by the

The foregoing Ordinance is duly passed by the Council . of the City of Lakeside, Oregon and approved by the Mayor, this 9th day of M.+4, 1975.
