ORDINANCE NO. 13

ORDER FOR ELECTION IN THE CITY OF LAKESIDE

An Ordinance providing for the submission of a proposal to the legal voters and calling and making provisions for an election therefor.

WHEREAS, The City Council deems it necessary and in the best interest of the City and its inhabitants that the City adopt a charter regulating and providing for the operation of City government, and

WHEREAS, the City has no charter at the present time.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF LAKESIDE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A Special City Election shall be held within the City of Lakeside, Coos County, Oregon, on the 11th day of May, 1976. At said Special City Election, the following proposal or question shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City for their approval or rejection:

PROPOSITION

SUBMITTED TO THE LEGAL VOTERS

BY

COUNCIL OF CITY OF LAKESIDE

Shall the City of Lakeside adopt the Charter known as "Lakeside Charter of 1976".

Section 2. The polling place for said election shall be at the Lakeside Rural Fire Department Fire Hall located on 9th Street within said City. Said polling place shall remain open between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M. and 8:00 o'clock P.M. on said election day.

Section 3. The election board shall consist of those persons appointed and acting as the City precinct election board pursuant to ORS 246.310 on the date of said election.

Section 4. The ballots for said election shall be

Section 5: The Election Officer of said City shall prepare the sample and official ballots for said election. Said Election Officer shall make arrangements for said election, and if any member of the Board of Election shall be unwilling or unable to serve as such, the Council shall appoint a qualified substitute.

Section 6. The Election Officer shall cause notice of the Special City Election to be posted in three conspicuous places within said District for a period of not less than 10 days prior to the date of holding said Special City Election and shall publish at least two times, the first publication shall not be more than 25 days nor less than 15 days preceding the election and the last publication shall be not more than 14 days nor less than 8 days preceding the election, in "The World", a newspaper of general circulation in said District.

Section 7. That the final draft of said "Lakeside Charter of 1976" be filed with the City Recorder on or before March 10, 1976, and that the Recorder keep and preserve the same until the results of said election are published. That

the Recorder shall keep and maintain, at all times during regular business hours of the City at the City's office, at least 10 certified copies of said Charter draft, available for public inspection and review. Said Recorder shall provide to any person, for his own use, a copy of said Charter upon the payment of \$1.50 which shall be deposited in the General Fund.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly passed by the City Council of the City of Lakeside on this 3rd day of March, 1976.
