

ORDINANCE NO. 14

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12 ADOPTED MARCH 3, 1976 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF LAKESIDE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4 of Ordinance No, 12, enacted March 3, 1976 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 4. The ballots for said election shall be in substantially the following form:

OFFICIAL BALLOT

For Special City Election in the City of Lakeside, to be held on May 11, 1976.

Vote Yes or No. Mark "X" or "√" in the square for the answer voted for.

Section 2. It is hereby declared necessary for peace, health and safety of the City of Lakeside and its inhabitants that this Ordinance be in full force and effect immediately in order to correct an error in the bond election ballot title before the election therefore, and on account thereof, the Council hereby declares an emergency to exist and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and is approved by the Mayor.

The foregoing Ordinance is duly passed by the Council of the City of Lakeside by majority vote of the Council and submitted to the Mayor and approved by the Mayor all on this 21st day of April, 1976.
