

ORDINANCE NO. 140

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE LAKESIDE CITY CEMETERY.

Section 1

The City will keep appropriate records of burials in Lakeside Cemetery beginning with January 1, 1990.

- A. State forms will be maintained as required.
- B. A bound ledger shall list all burials beginning on January 1, 1990 in chronological order.

Section 2

The City Recorder shall be the sexton and maintain lists of burials and provide appropriate documentations of burials as required. The records of Lakeside Cemetery shall be kept at Lakeside City Hall, 915 North Lake Ave. and will be available for inspection during normal business hours.

Section 3

Parties wishing to have a body buried in the Lakeside Cemetery are responsible for costs of opening and closing graves, and will provide the city with a waiver of responsibility.

Section 4

The City of Lakeside may require burials to be made in uniform rows, but interested parties may chose the exact plot.


Section 5


The business hours of operation of the cemetery shall be from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., week days. In cases where death necessitates discussion of burial on week-ends, the mayor and one city council person are designated assistant sextons.

- A. No person shall be in the cemetery in the hours it is closed except on lawful business.
- B. Motor Vehicles attendant to a burial may be within the boundaries, as may vehieles on lawful business. All other vehicles are forbidden.
- C. Violation of Section 5 of Ordinance No. 140 shall be a misdemeanor and will be subjected to a fine of not more than one hundred dollars and ten days in jail.
