## ORDINANCE NO. 15

## ORDER FOR ELECTION IN THE CITY OF LAKESIDE

An Ordinance providing for the submission of a proposal to the legal voters and calling and making provisions for an election therefor.

WHEREAS, an initiation petition has been filed by voters of the City requesting the placing of a proposition on the ballot for the City in the State General Election to be held November 2, 1976 and the Council having determined that said petition is in order and pursuant to ORS 254.130 and the City Charter;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF LAKESIDE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: A City Election shall be held within the City of Lakeside, Coos County, Oregon on the 2nd day of November, 1976. At said City Election, the following proposal or question shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City for their approval or rejection:

Shall the following public officials of this City be required to file a statement of economic interest with the Oregon Government Ethics Commission: Each person holding an elective city office; each member of a city planning, zoning or development commission; and each chief executive officer of the city who performs the duties of manager or a principal administrator of the city:

Section 2: The polling place for said election shall be at the Lakeside Rural Fire Department Fire Hall located on

9th Street within said City. Said polling place shall remain open between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M. and 8:00 o'clock P.M. on said election day.

Section 3: The election board shall consist of those persons appointed and acting as the City precinct election board pursuant to ORS 246.310 on the date of said election.
