

ORDINANCE #152

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEASING OF SOUTH EEL CREEK CAMPGROUND; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER TO ENTER A LEGAL AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES FOREST SERVICE; PROVIDING FOR THE CITY TO OPERATE SOUTH EEL CREEK CAMPGROUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Lakeside may be able to lease through a Special Use Permit the property known as South Eel Creek Campground; and

WHEREAS, the leasing of South Eel Creek property offers the opportunity to add to the recreational facilities of the area and to promote the general health and welfare of the City's residents.

THE CITY OF LAKESIDE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) The City shall acquire by a Special Use Permit for a twenty (20) year period the South Eel Creek Campground from the United States Forest Service.


Section (2) The Mayor and City Recorder are authorized to negotiate and enter into an agreement with the United States Forest Service relating to the leasing and operation of the South Eel Creek Campground.


Section (3) The Council of the City of Lakeside hereby declares an emergency to exist and this Ordinance shall become effective upon its enactment by the Council.
