ORDINANCE NO. 20

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TIME, MANNER AND MEANS FOR HOLDING SPECIAL ELECTIONS IN THE CITY.

THE CITY OF LAKESIDE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All special elections held by the City shall be conducted pursuant to this ordinance.

Section 2. The Council may by ordinance or resolution call a special election for any purpose authorized by law or the City Charter.

Section 3. Certain sections of Chapter 259, Oregon Revised Statutes, existing on the date this ordinance is adopted shall be incorporated herein by reference. For the purposes of this ordinance all acts required to be performed by the election officer shall be performed by the City Recorder, those by the election authority by the City Council and those by the District Attorney by the City Attorney. Where "District" is used it shall mean City of Lakeside.

Section 4. When a special election is to be held, the Council shall deliver to the Recorder a notice stating the date of the election, the place of the election, the hours during which the polls will be open, a ballot title and statement of purpose, and a brief description of each matter to be submitted to the voters. The Council, at its discretion, shall determine the nature and extent of the description of matters to be submitted to the voters.

Section 5. The Recorder shall publish the Notice of Election once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City. However, if there is a newspaper of general circulation that is published in the City, the notice shall be published in such newspaper. The Council shall designate such newspaper and shall notify the Recorder thereof in the notice of election. Not later than the fourth day nor sooner than the 15th day before the election, the Recorder shall cause to be published a facsimile, except as to size, of the sample ballot, a list of the polling places and the hours the polls are to be open. The information shall be published once in a newspaper designated by the Council under Section 5 of this ordinance at the current published local display advertising rate. In addition, the Recorder shall post a copy of the facsimile in three conspicuous public places within the City at least ten days before the date of the special election.

Section 6. The following Sections of Oregon Revised Statutes are hereby adopted and incorporated herein by reference and shall be a part hereof and be in full force and effect within the City: ORS 259.120, 259.140, 259.150, 259.160, 259.180, 259.200 and 259.210.

Section 7. Special elections shall be held on any Tuesday.

Section 8. Whereas the Council has determined that it is necessary to hold a special election to vote on the tax levy for 1977-78 and whereas the Charter requires the Council to adopt procedures for holding special elections and whereas such procedures are immediately necessary and thereby an emergency is declared to exist requiring that this ordinance become effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and its being signed by the Mayor.

The foregoing ordinance was duly passed by the City Council of the City of Lakeside and approved by the Mayor this 29th day of June, 1977.
