

CITY OF LAKESIDE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 19 OF THE CITY OF LAKESIDE BY ADDING AND CHANGING CERTAIN PROVISIONS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF LAKESIDE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 21 is amended to read as follows:

Land Partitioning Procedure For Approval. Land Partitioning creating a road or street and not more than three lots shall be known as a major partition. Land partitioning of land located on an existing public road, such as an existing City, County or State road or right-of-way into not more than three parcels, shall be known as a minor partition. Land partitioning, either major or minor, shall be approved under the following procedure.

(1) There shall be submitted to the appointed city representative three tracings of a preliminary map, 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ by 11 inches in size, with the following information:

(5) Upon approval of the preliminary map the applicant shall have prepared by a registered land surveyor a final plat map showing the final approved land division and conditions. Said final plat map shall be reviewed by a Planning Commission representative for Compliance, signed and dated. One copy shall be kept by the city and one copy shall be filed with the County Land Surveyor.

Section 2. An emergency is declared to exist so that this ordinance becomes effective immediately upon its passage and signing by the mayor because of pending applications for a minor partition.


The foregoing ordinance is duly passed by the Council of the city of Lakeside, Oregon, and approved by the Mayor this 19th day of March, 1981.
