

Repealed #162.A

AN ORDINANCE INTERPRETING CHAPTER III SECTION 8 OF THE LAKESIDE CITY CHARTER
THE CITY OF LAKESIDE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. When a council position is vacated prior to its normal termination, that vacancy shall be filled subject to the provisions of Chapter VII, Section 2 of the Lakeside City Charter. Therefore, at any given regular general election, circumstances could require some council positions to be filled for two year terms at the same time others are beign filled for four year terms.

Section 2. In applying Chapter III, Section 8, Sentence 8 of the Lakeside City Charter, "...the candidates receiving the highest number of votes each among all the other candidates shall be elected.", the following interpretation shall apply:


a) In awarding council positions, four year terms shall be awarded to the candidates receiving the highest number of votes until all four year terms are filled.

b) After all four year terms are filled, two year terms shall be awarded to the remaining candidates receiving the highest number of votes until all two year terms are filled.

Section 3. The council finds that to facilitate an orderly election, this ordinance is mandated prior to the November 2, 1982 general election and therefore declares an emergency to exist, requiring this Ordinance to take effect upon its adoption and signature by the Mayor.


