

ORDINANCE NUMBER 90

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF THAT CERTAIN FRANCHISE AGREEMENT SET FORTH IN ORDINANCE NO. 47 OF THE CITY OF LAKESIDE TO NORTHLAND CABLE PROPERTIES ONE, A LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, NORTHLAND COMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION, GENERAL PARTNER.

The City of Lakeside Ordains as follows:

Section 1: Consent to Transfer: Subject to the provisions of this Ordinance the City of Lakeside hereby consents to the transfer of that certain franchise granted under Ordinance No. 47 of the City of Lakeside to Cable TV Corporation, from Cable TV Corporation to Northland Cable Properties One, a Limited Partnership, Northland Communications Corporation, general partner.

Section 2: Nonexclusive Franchise: In clarification of the provisions of Ordinance No. 47 the same is hereby declared to constitute a non-exclusive franchise for the use of streets, alleys and public easements within the City of Lakeside for the operation of a cable television communications system.

Section 3: Invalidity: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or portion of this ordinance or of City of Lakeside Ordinance No. 47, is for any reason held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or of City of Lakeside Ordinance No. 47.

Section 4: Confirmation of Previous Ordinance: Except as the terms and provisions of Ordinance No. 47 conflict with or are

nconsistent with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance,
City of Lakeside Ordinance No. 47 is hereby ratified and
affirmed.

The foregoing ordinance is duly passed by the Council
of the City of Lakeside, Oregon and approved by the Mayor this
19th day of May, 1983.
