

**ORDINANCE NO. 10-268A
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 10-268**

WHEREAS, the Council desires that Ordinance No. 10-268 be amended to reflect new terms for standing committees,

THE CITY OF LAKESIDE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

10-268, an Ordinance relating to elections is amended as follows:

1. **Section 3 is amended to read as follows:**

The members of this Board/committee shall remain in their position for a period of no longer than a 4-year term. At that time, their seat must go in front of the City Council for a renewal of another 4-year term. They MUST contact the City Council, in writing, 60 days prior to the end of their term and tell the Council if they intend to reapply for the seat or not. If they wish to reapply, they MUST do so in that writing to the Council. This provides the Council with time to post Notice to the public of the opening of the position. Any other person fitting that particular seat's qualification category may also apply for that seat by writing a letter to the Council at least 60 days prior to that new term.

Therefore, this Ordinance shall become effective 30 days upon its passage by the City Council and approval by the Mayor.
