

ORDINANCE NO. 11-272
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING Ordinance 06-253

WHEREAS, the Council desires that the City Charter and Ordinance No.11-272 are not in conflict,

THE CITY OF LAKESIDE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

06-253A, an Ordinance relating to elections is amended as follows:

1. **Section 1.02.01 is amended to read as follows:**

A qualified elector who has resided in the City of Lakeside during the past 30 days immediately preceding the election may be a candidate for an elective city position.

2. **Section 1.02.02(B) is amended to read as follows:**

A declaration of candidacy must be accompanied by any filing fee established by Council resolution.

3. **Section 1.02.03(B) is amended to read as follows:**

A declaration of candidacy must include a statement that any required fee is included with the declaration.

4. **Section 1.02.06(B) is amended to read as follows:**

If requested not later than 67 days before election date, the recorder will refund the filing fee, if any so paid, of a candidate who dies, withdraws, or becomes ineligible for the nomination.

5. **Section 1.03.01 is amended to read as follows:**

A city elective office becomes vacant as provided by the City Charter Section 31.

6. **Section 1.03.02(B) is amended to read as follows:**

A vacancy in an elective office must be filled as provided by city charter section 32.

In order to facilitate the clear establishment of rules for this year's election, an emergency is declared and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.
