

RESOLUTION 07-02

A Resolution to Accept Department of State Lands Funding to conduct Tenmile Lakefront surveys.

WHEREAS, the water quality of the Tenmile Lakes continues to deteriorate; and

WHEREAS, in the Summer of 2002, a severe drought year, levels of toxic algae, namely *Microcystis aeruginosa* and *Anabaena flos-aquae* gave cause for concern with the health and welfare of users of the Tenmile lakes; and

WHEREAS, any clean up of the Tenmile Lakes will require large sums of money; and Government.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE Lakeside City Council accepts, allocates, and authorizes \$10,950.00 of state funding to conduct Lakefront surveys in it's efforts to start the long and arduous tasks of improving water quality, enhancement coho salmon levels, and promoting the attractiveness of the Tenmile Lakes as a recreational center.
