

RESOLUTION 07-18

A Resolution to support the efforts of the Tenmile Lakes' Basin Partnership in its quest to secure federal congressional support and federal funding.

WHEREAS, the water quality of the Tenmile Lakes continues to deteriorate; and

WHEREAS, in the Summer of 2007, a sever drought year, levels of toxic algae, namely *Microcystis aeruginosa* and *Anabaena flos-aquae* gave cause for concern with the health and welfare of users of the twin lakes; and

WHEREAS, any clean up of the Tenmile Lakes will require large sums of money; and Government.


