

RESOLUTION 09-04

A Resolution to Accept Department of State Lands Funding to conduct Tenmile Lake surveys.

WHEREAS, the water quality of the Tenmile Lakes continues to deteriorate; and

WHEREAS, in the Summer of 2002, a sever drought year, levels of toxic algae, namely *Microcystis aeroginosa* and *Anabaena flos-aquae* gave cause for concern with the health and welfare of users of the twin lakes; and

WHEREAS, any clean up of the Tenmile Lakes will require large sums of money; and Government.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE Lakeside City Council accepts, allocates, and authorizes \$2,500.00 of state DSL funding to conduct Lake sampling in its efforts to start the long and arduous tasks of improving water quality, enhancement coho salmon levels, and promoting the attractiveness of the Tenmile Lakes as a recreational center.

- A. By this agreement the Department of State Lands (DSL) agrees to provide funding in the amount of \$2,500.00 for monitoring of the Tenmile Lakes for Microcystis aeruginosa and its toxins during the 2009 public use season (June through September 2009). *Microcystis aeruginosa* presents a threat to the public health, welfare and safety of the residents and visitors of Tenmile Lakes. These lakes are state-owned property.
- B. The City of Lakeside passed a Resolution endorsing this project.
- C. The City of Lakeside shall use of the funds to monitor the water quality condition of the Tenmile Lakes in accordance with a monitoring plan developed in consultation with the Oregon Department of Health, Department of Environmental Quality and other knowledge interests.
- D. The funds shall be combined with other project funds contributed by other interested parties.
- E. The City of Lakeside shall provide a year-end monitoring report to the DSL at the close of the public use season.
