

RESOLUTION 10-14

A Resolution to Accept Department of State Lands Funding to conduct Tenmile Lake surveys.

WHEREAS, the water quality of the Tenmile Lakes continues to deteriorate; and

WHEREAS, in the Summer of 2002, a sever drought year, levels of toxic algae, namely *Microcystis aeroginosa* and *Anabaena flos-aquae* gave cause for concern with the health and welfare of users of the twin lakes; and


WHEREAS, any clean up of the Tenmile Lakes will require large sums of money; and Government.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE Lakeside City Council accepts, allocates, and authorizes \$2,500.00 of state DSL funding to conduct Lake sampling in it's efforts to start the long and arduous tasks of improving water quality, enhancement coho salmon levels, and promoting the attractiveness of the Tenmile Lakes as a recreational center.
